One of the fastest ways to do the job is to use some cleaning wipes, like this new range from Big Wipes. Five kinds are offered: Exterior, Glass, Interior, Leather

and Protectant. The Exterior wipes use high-performance solvents to remove dirt, oil, tar, fingerprints, insects and bird lime. Each is made of soft fabric that doesn't scratch paintwork and leaves a smear-free shine.

The Glass wipes shift road grime and dead insects from windows and mirrors, and can be used inside and out. For the rest of the cabin, the Interior

Hi-tech 12V 'jump lead' is in charge

FLAT batteries are no fun, but fiddling about with booster cables in the cold and dark to fire your car back into life is even more miserable. It's all too easy to hook up to the wrong terminal and damage the electrical system - unless you invest in the new Car2Car Starter from Ring Automotive.

There's no need to even lift the bonnet if your battery is dead, because one end of the device plugs into the stricken car's 12V socket, and the other into the same

on a running vehicle. Usefully, the Car2Car Starter comes supplied with five metres of cable between the connectors, so there is more than enough wiring to stretch from one socket to another.

After being plugged in for 15 minutes, the battery should be rejuvenated. A microprocessor in the charger ensures the correct charge is delivered. The sole downside is that the hi-tech system is suitable only for engines up to 1.6 litres in capacity.
